		4.	3 Originals	Three <b>recent</b> passport-sized <b>photos</b> according to the ICAO regulations.
		5.	Original + 2 Copies	<b>Passport</b> with at least three empty pages. Issued less than 10 years ago and valid for at least 12 months at the point of visa application.  Copy of bio-data pages (this includes the signature page) + previous Schengen visas.
		6.	Original	Malaysia resident permit
		0.	+ 2 Copies	Employment pass/Dependant's pass/Work permit/Student pass/Permanent Resident card + Re- entry Permit/
		7.	Original	Official copy of your birth certificate (proof that you are over 21 years old) issued less than 6

		10.	Original	<b>Legalized certificate of good conduct</b> (for 21 years old and above) issued less than 6 months ago by your country of residence or country of origin.  To obtain a "Certificate of Good Conduct" in Malaysia, kindly contact the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia + legalization by the Embassy of Belgium in Malaysia (fees apply)
		11.	2 Copies	Work Permit / Professional Card / European Blue Card / Host Agreement of your spouse
		12.	Original + 2 Copies	<b>Medical Insurance Certificate</b> issued by the Health Insurer in Belgium (mutuelle / mutualiteit) Proof that your spouse has a health insurance policy covering medical costs in Belgium for him / her and the family / employment contract including a clause regarding health insurance coverage / travel insurance certificate + policy covering all risks and costs (medical and repatriation) in Belgium for at least 30 000 EUR (or its equivalent) and valid for a duration of 3 months.
		13.	2 Copies	<b>Proof of sufficient accommodation</b> of your spouse in Belgium. Lease agreement / employment contract including a clause regarding housing / hotel reservation.

		15.	2 Copies	<b>Proof of payment of the administrative fee</b> . Only possible via bank transfer and to be paid prior to the visa application. Cannot be paid at the Embassy.
		16.		Accepted proof of vaccination: You are fully vaccinated 2 weeks after your last vaccination dose with an EMA approved vaccine or Covishield.

## I HAVE BEEN INFORMED THAT:
