		1.	Original	This checklist, with boxes ticked and documents in the sequence of this checklist.
		2.	Original	Print-out confirmation email, that you have an appointment for your visa application.
		3.	2 Originals	Two $\underline{\text{visa application forms}}$ properly completed. Signed and dated in field 36 + 37 as well as on the last page of the form.
		4.	3 Originals	Three recent passport-sized photos according to the ICAO regulations.
		5.	Original + 2 Copies	Passport with at least three empty pages. Issued less than 10 years ago and valid for at least 12 months at the point of visa application. Copy of bio-data pages (this includes the signature page) + previous Schengen visas.
		6.	Original + 2 Copies	Malaysia resident permit Employment pass/Dependant's pass/Work permit/Student pass/Permanent Resident card + Reentry Permit/
		7.	Original + 2 Copies	Official copy of your birth certificate (proof that you are over 21 years old) issued less than 6 months ago If it is issued in Malaysia: Extract of Births issued by the National Registration Department in Malaysia, authenticated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Malaysia and legalized by the Embassy.(fees apply) See procedure of legalization of documents, if document was issued abroad.
		8.	Original + 2 Copies	Official copy of your marriage certificate, issued less than 6 months ago If it is issued in Malaysia: Extract of Marriage certificate (for Civil marriage) and Certificate copy (Religious marriage), authenticated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Malaysia and legalized by the Embassy. (fees apply) Official copy of the divorce certificate or judgement (if applicable) See procedure of legalization of documents.
		9.	Original	Medical certificate issued less than 6 months ago. It must be properly filled out and stamped and signed by the medical doctor designated by the Embassy. Kindly contact Clinic Segara at +60321632140
		10.	Original	Legalized certificate of good conduct (for 21 years old and above) issued less than 6 months ago by your country of residence or country of origin. To obtain a "Certificate of Good Conduct" in Malaysia, kindly contact the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia + legalization by the Embassy of Belgium in Malaysia (fees apply)
		11.	2 Copies	Belgian Residence card + Passport copy of your spouse in Belgium (titre de séjour / verblijfkaart).
		12.	Original + 2 Copies	Medical Insurance certificate issued by the Health Insurer in Belgium (mutuelle/ mutualiteit). Proof that your spouse has a health insurance policy covering medical costs in Belgium for him / her and the family
		13.	2 Copies	Proof of sufficient accommodation of your spouse in Belgium. Registered lease agreement or notarized housing title allocated to principal residence of your partner in Belgium.
		14.	2 Copies	Proof of your spouse's regular and sufficient means of subsistence Attestation of family composition + salary slips of the last 12 months / last income tax statement for professionals / pensions /
		15.	Original + 2 Copies	Proof of payment of the <u>contribution fee</u> , to be paid prior to the visa application. The contribution fee cannot be paid at the Embassy.
		16.	•	Visa fee: RM936 payable by card/bank transfer not refundable and subject to change. Legalization fee: RM104 per document

I HAVE BEEN INFORMED THAT:

- my passport will be kept for the duration of the visa processing time.
- my application will only be eligible for processing when the submitted file is complete.
- additional documents may be requested.

FOR MINORS, a separate application needs to be submitted with all documents listed above (except marriage certificate). If the child is from a previous partnership, an additional document needs to be submitted:

- shared custody: an original official and legalized letter of consent from the other parent
- sole custody: a legal and legalized document of sole custody.
